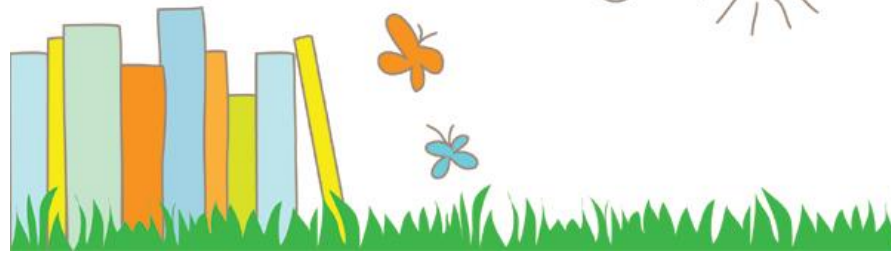


Summer Reading
